Observations during the Survey:

- 1.Drinking water is not available during summer
- 2. There is no Primary Health Centre, Private Clinic in the village, for which they have to travel about 12 kms to reach the nearest government hospital.
- 3. Agriculture here is totally dependent on monsoon as there are no major water bodies and water storage facilities available in the vicinity.
- 4. Due to the limited agricultural activities many families have migrated to the nearby cities in search of employment.
- 5. Majority of them come under the category of small and marginal farmers, hence per capita income is low

Outcome: After the survey, it was found that the village is deprived of many basic facilities like health services, public transport, water storage facilities, secondary school, etc. Majority of the people are unaware of the various government schemes which are meant for rural development
