



41AC05.01: Approval for Change in Examination Scheme and General Guidelines for Question Paper Setters for Honors & Double Minor Courses.		
Discussion	The committee reviewed the proposed modifications to the examination scheme for Honors and Double Minor courses. Members highlighted the need to align the scheme with university regulations, outcome-based education principles, and the	

	unique requirements of specialized courses. It was emphasized that the examination scheme should encourage analytical thinking, application-based learning, and flexibility for interdisciplinary courses.		
Resolution	After detailed deliberation, the committee unanimously approved the proposed changes to the Examination Scheme and General Guidelines for Question Paper Setters for Honors and Double Minor courses. The changes will be effective from the current academic session. The Dean Academics will circulate the final guidelines to all concerned faculty members and departments in consultation with the Dean Exam.

Discussion	The committee discussed the recent SPPU University Circular dated 16th September 2025 mandating the inclusion of an additional 2-credit course in PG programs. It was noted that this measure aims to enhance academic rigor, provide exposure to emerging areas, and ensure uniformity across affiliated institutions.		
Resolution	The Academic Council unanimously resolved to approve the inclusion of the additional 2-credit course in the PG Programs (MBA, PG in Computers, PG in Mechanical) as per the SPPU University Circular dated 16th September 2025. The proposed curriculum for the respective programs was also approved. The revised structure will be effective from the Academic Year 2024–25, Semester II.
