The organization has plans in place for how it will conduct its operations on the green areas. Institutional planning and organizing documents should include these techniques in order to build a clean and green campus.

a) Save Energy Tips:

- Enable the power management functions on your computer and monitor so that when you
 aren't using them. they enter a low power "sleep" mode.
- Make sure your monitor is off when you leave your table.
- Turn the power management settings on for your laser printer to "on."
- Try to log off rather than shutting down whenever you can.
- Avoid wasting electricity by using the daylight instead. Use small fluorescent or LEDs.
- When not in use, turn off the lights in conference rooms, classrooms, and lecture halls.
- Use fans only when it is necessary.

b) Waste Management

We have garbage bins located in each laboratory. Waste that is collected is divided into three categories: food waste and paper waste collected in green color dustbin, Chemicals and plastic collected in blue dustbin and broken glassware are collected in black color waste bin.

c) Ban on Plastic

Due to its negative effects on land, water, human health and general public wellbeing, plastic garbage has become one of the most significant environmental challenges. By outright prohibiting plastic, we have taken the initiative to make the SNJB campus "plastic free."

d) Utilization of solar power

Because of solar power's many advantages—such as its dependability, affordability, and environmental friendliness—its use has grown dramatically over time. Solar panels are mounted on the rooftops of all colleges on the SNJB campus in order to produce electricity.

As a result, there is now less dependence on fossil fuels for energy, which lowers greenhouse gas emissions.

e) Digital Library/E-Learning Centre

Add more soft readout content (using online resources). Simplify the complex readout material. Use email more frequently for perusing the internet, exchanging official information, and other objectives. Instead of using paper notices, transmit and receive messages and information via email.

f) Green Audit (Waste, Water, Energy, Biodiversity)

A green audit is the methodical identification, measurement, documentation, reporting, and analysis of environmental diversity components. The organization will examine the work done by organizations whose activities pose a risk to the environment and the health of its residents in order to analyze environmental practices both inside and outside the SNJB campus, which will have an effect on the eco-friendly atmosphere. We will receive guidance on how to improve the state of the environment through Green Audit, and a number of factors have contributed to the expansion of this practice.

Scope of Green Audit

- To review of solid waste management activities implemented by college.
- To review of liquid waste management activities implemented by college.
- To review of e-waste management activities implemented by college.
- To review of feasibility of Rain Water Harvesting System in college campus.
- To review the feasibility of Biogas Generation Plant by collecting the data of canteen waste.
- To review of existing solar power plant in line with green initiative by college.
- To review of solar water heater system installed at Hostel in line with green initiative Society.
- To suggest good practices to college staff, students for Green initiative by implementing various small level projects in college campus.
- To discuss on the audit report and finalizing the action plan to resolve those issues.

This Policy document is being made effective from 1st July 2020.



Station of Solar Panel:












