EXAMINATION FEEDBACK ANALYSIS 2018-19

To Mr. M. S. Mahajan College Examination officer SNJB's SSDJ College of Pharmacy, Chandwad

Following the recent feedback collected from students (282) regarding the examination process, we have undertaken a thorough analysis based on the responses to ten critical questions. The feedback, provided by students, has been instrumental in understanding their experience and identifying areas for improvement.

Summary of Feedback Analysis:

- Clarity of Examination Timetable: A significant majority of students found the information on the examination timetable to be clear and easy to understand, with most respondents selecting "Always" (254, 90.07%) or "Mostly." This suggests that the current communication method is effective.
- Ease of Locating Exam Venues: Most students indicated that the exam venues were easy to locate, with responses predominantly in the "Always" (266, 94.32%) and "Mostly" categories. This reflects positively on the signage and directions provided.
- Explanation of University/Internal Exam Rules: The feedback indicates that a large number
 of students feel the exam rules are adequately provided or explained, with "Always" (272,
 96.45%) and "Mostly" being the most common responses. However, there is a small portion
 that feels this could be improved.
- 4. Preferred Format for Communicating Exam Rules: Students showed a preference for receiving exam rules via email (15.95%) and social media (48.22%), along with Notice board (71.98%) suggesting a trend towards digital communication. The notice board and oral communication were less favored, indicating a potential shift in communication strategies.
- 5. Instructions on Handling Personal Belongings in Exam Venues: The majority of students confirmed that they were clearly instructed on where to place their belongings, with most responses being "Always (268, 95.05%)" or "Mostly." This highlights effective management in the examination halls.
- Implementation of Arrangements in the Examination Hall: The feedback shows that
 arrangements like seating and availability of drinking water were generally well-implemented,
 with most students choosing "Always" or "Mostly." This indicates a satisfactory level of
 comfort and organization.
- Responsiveness of Invigilators: The majority of students felt that invigilators were quick to respond when assistance was needed, with positive feedback in the "Always" and "Mostly" categories. This reflects the attentiveness of the invigilation team.
- 8. Faculty Feedback on Exam Performance: There was a mixed response regarding the feedback provided by faculty on exam performance, with some students indicating that they received feedback "Always" or "Mostly," while others reported less frequent feedback. This could be an area to explore further for enhancement.


